There are two ways to breed lovebirds: in large aviary groups or by individual pairs in separate breeding cages. The white eye-ring group of lovebirds are particularly well suited to colony breeding. The Eggs and Chicks Female lovebirds usually lay their first egg 7-10 days after copulation, with an additional egg being produced at intervals of 1-2 days thereafter. A full clutch consists of 4-7 eggs, and most females do not begin incubating until several eggs have been laid. Usually, the hen sits and is fed by the male.

Lovebird Breeding Problems: Cautions for Small Parrot Breeders

Check that your lovebirds have enough space. As lovebirds love to fly and move around, always provide the most space possible. Your lovebirds will be much happier in a roomy environment that lets them live more naturally. The minimum amount of space for one lovebird is 24 inches (60 cm) wide by 14 inches (35 cm) deep by 30 (76 cm) inches high.

samples or DNA (such as from shed feathers). These can then be analysed by a laboratory to be certain of their sex. An alternative method is to ask your vet to surgically sex your birds, where he or she will inspect the bird's cloaca to ascertain their sex.

Dutch Blue lovebirds take about a full year to reach their jewel-like bluish green coloring. These are not “true blue” birds like you get with Fischer’s – for this reason you won’t get an albino peachfaced lovebird (which is a blue-based bird) but you can get albino Fischer’s lovebirds.
